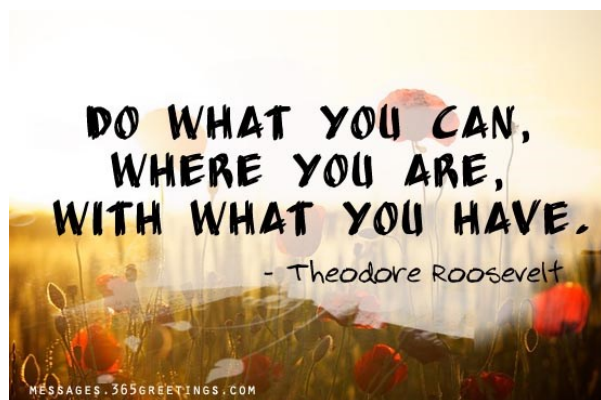

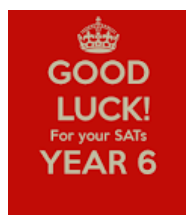
### Ofsted priorities
